 - Item I will and desire is that all my Household furniture & Stock of every kind shall be equally Divided between my Two Daughters upon Avey & Prudence Fourman to them and their heirs for ever if there be any thing left after the Death of my loving Wife

Lastly I Nominate and do appoint my loving Wife Jane Butt my Executrix and my friend Peter Butt Executors of this my last Will and Testament in confirmation whereof I have thereunto set my Hand and Seal this Twenty fifth of October 1776
